



Italian Agriculture

- Italy's agricultural sector and agri-food system are strong contributors to the country's economy, accounting for around 2% and 15% of the GDP respectively.
- Italian agriculture represents a unique mixture of different climates, soils and topography, resulting in one of the most diversified agricultural outputs in the EU.





Italian agriculture

- Northern regions: cereals, soybeans, meat and dairy products
- Southern regions: fruits, vegetables, olive oil, wine and durum wheat.
- Italy has the largest number of agrifood products with Protected Designations of Origin and Protected Geographical Indications recognised by the EU.





Italian agriculture

Italy is the largest producer of wine in the world, and one of the leading producers of olive oil, fruits (apples, olives, grapes, oranges, lemons, pears, apricots, hazelnuts, peaches, cherries, plums, strawberries, and kiwifruits), and vegetables (especially artichokes and tomatoes).





The Italian agriculture

The Italian agriculture (including silviculture and fisheries) produced in 2022:

- 1.1 million farms,
- 75 billion euro worth goods (third biggest in Europe),
- 37 billion euro added value (second biggest in Europe),
- 3.7 % of national GDP.





The Italian food and agriculture system

The Italian food and agriculture system (2022):

- 550 billion euro total value,
- 64 billion euro added value,
- 15 % of national GDP,
- 1,3 million companies (from agriculture to restaurants)
 (25%)
- 3,2 million employees,
- 13% of total number







- Export agroalimentare vicino ai 60 miliardi (+16%), Import agroalimentare 63 miliardi (+29,3%)


